Senior Vice Commander:

- Sr. Vice Commander Puente Reported:

He asks Post 216 to approve \$218 from Poppy Funds to support the Marines to make the total contributions \$300.00. Support was Ron Nevorski. After discussion the original motion was amended to take the money form the General Fund with Support from Nevorski and Janoska. The motion carried by voice vote.

Historian:

• No report.

Membership: Membership Chairman Bruce Hayden reported:

- Post 216 is at 100.77% membership for 2008. The post has 33 new members, today we have 399 members + 4 deceased members = 403 total members. Our 2008 goal was 392 members.. This has significantly helped the 18th District to be the first District in Michigan to reach 100% Membership.

Veterans Honors & Ceremonial Committee:

- John Moore thanked Rich. Chowaniec for his hard work in managing Phase 1 of the Honor Guard Certification.
- John Moore reported that there is a get well card being passed tonight for Lance Olberg. Please sign it.

Bingo: Co-Bingo Chairman Bruce Hayden reported:

Legion Riders: Commander Nelson passed the gavel to Sr. Vice Puente and presented the following report:

Boys State: A motion was made by Bob Janoska and supported by Joe Salvia to pay for 2 scholarships to Boys State @ \$310.00 per scholarship along with another \$16.00 per boy for yearbooks.. The motion carried by voice vote.

Scholarship: Commander Nelson reported that the Scholarship Committee has to select the 2 recipients for the Scholarships.

Memorial Day: Committee Chairman Joe Salvia Reported:

- We have 3 meetings including this one to ramp up for the ceremonies. Progress is being made but there is a lot left to do.
- SAL and Auxiliary will handle the luncheon again this year.
- The goal as always is to have over 1000 Veterans in the Parade.

Poppy: Bob Janoska reported that Poppy Days is in May. Volunteers are needed to solicit donations on May 15 thru 17th.

Unfinished Business:

- Outdoor lights and Flag Array: Joe Salvia reported that we need to get the village concurrence that the Post is in accordance with their ordnance.
- **Air Quality Improvements:** Commander Nelson passed the gavel to Sr. Vice Puente and reported:
 - 1. The Executive Board reviewed the improvements that are done and pending.
 - 2. The total cost should be in the neighborhood of \$22,000.00 with all improvements expected to be complete by the end of March 2008..

New Business:

- Correspondence:
 - 1. The Adjutant read a note from Team Wicked of the Breast Cancer 3 Day Event thanking the membership and Post 216 for our donation to their cause. The Post charged the event planners the normal cost for the rent on the Hall and then donated the rental fee back to the event...
- **Recognition of Guests from K of C:** The guests from the Milford K of C 4th Degree Council talked to the membership of their requirements relating to patriotism and a desire to join with the Post on helping Veterans, programs and parades. Commander Nelson proposed a liaison

committee composed of Bob Janoska, and Joe Salvia as liaison with the K of C Council. The proposal carried.

Good of the Legion:

- Commander Nelson reported that Election of Officers will be conducted at the April Meeting.
- Bob Janoska made a motion that the Post donate \$300.00 toward the cost of purchasing a Troop Flag for Boy Scout Troop 33. Support was Joe Salvia. The motion carried by voice vote.
- Rich Chowaniec Vice Chairman of the Milford Memorial Cemetery Committee reported that the committee was complaining about the broken and damaged flags on the ground in the cemetery. Joe Salvia will work with the 4th Degree K of C Council to review, inspect, and maintain the flags on the graves. Tony Puente added that the Boy Scouts will assist in this project also.
- Angelo Pellegata reported that a fund raiser auction is scheduled for June 2008 in the Post Parking Lot. No specific date has been set yet. Donations of merchandise valued at \$25.00 or more are being asked for. Letters to businesses in and around Milford along with Posters will be seen in the near future.
