

Standing Rules

1. The Post Commander is granted \$250 in discretionary expense spending per transaction. (From June 16, 2015, General Membership meeting minutes).
2. Emergency expense funding, such as the breakdown of the building furnace or A/C unit. As long as the Club Room manager, or the building chairperson, contacts the board to advice of the emergency situation, then the emergency funding will be authorized. This is different than say the cost to resurface the parking lot, which is not an emergency situation that would be presented to General Membership for review and approval. (From June 16, 2015, General Membership meeting minutes).
3. A policy has been implemented that any person that financially obligates the Post for non-emergency related expenses, aside from the Commander's \$250 discretionary expense authorization, without the prior consent of the general membership, can be held personally liable for the expense. (From July 14, 2015, Executive Committee meeting minutes).
4. The Executive Board decided the start date for new officers will be the 1st Executive Board meeting following the election process. This will allow the incoming officers to coordinate with the departing officers the passing of the office. (From June 14, 2016, Executive Committee meeting minutes).
5. The Executive Board decided in regards to the election vote process, tie breakers will be determined by a re-vote of present members, and the Post Commander will not cast a vote. (From June 14, 2016, Executive Committee meeting minutes).
6. General membership voted to allow a listing of Legion member names in local publications designed to honor them for their service to our country, during such times as Memorial Day and the 4th of July holidays. (From June 21, 2016, General Membership meeting minutes).
7. The Executive Board has agreed, in regards to the Poppy Fund monetary distribution process, the poppy chairperson has sole distribution authority up to \$500. Anything over \$500 will require the concurrence of the Finance Officer, unless the Finance Officer is unavailable. In the event the Finance Officer cannot be contacted, then the poppy chairperson must obtain concurrence of one other Executive Board member prior to distribution of the funds. (From February 15, 2017, Executive Committee meeting minutes).
8. Senator Rumstead's office contacted the post for an email list of members so his office can send out a note of thanks to all veterans of our Post for Veterans Day. It was decided by membership that we would not release our emails to a political office. However, the Adjutant will be the gate keeper of emails from State or other government entities that would be distributed to members by the Adjutant via the Post's email address. (From October 17, 2017, General Membership meeting minutes).
9. A \$20,000 CD was purchased out of the General Fund balance with membership approval at the August meeting. (From September 18, 2018, General Membership meeting minutes).
10. Any member (Legion, Auxiliary, SAL) who volunteers at bingo at least 12 times in one year will have his / her applicable dues paid by the Post. (Reaffirmed September 17th, 2019, General membership meeting minutes)
